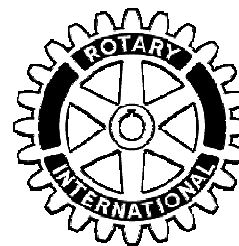

Last Week's Program – DUI

Mike Lentini of Roman and Roman, Attorneys at Law, in Clearwater spoke on the topic of DUI from the perspective of a criminal defense attorney. He stressed that it is not illegal to drink and drive, BUT it is illegal to drive while faculties are impaired. This very common crime can happen to anyone and can result in your arrest. DUI is serious and defendants are entitled to a jury trial, which can be expensive and result in loss of one's driver's license. Protocol must be followed after a traffic stop: if the police officer detains you improperly, illegal search and seizure may result. An officer who conducts a preliminary investigation at a traffic accident must give the driver a Miranda Rights statement before proceeding with an investigation of a DUI. The accident report contains privileged information that cannot be used later in a criminal procedure. There are several indicators that may result in a DUI stop including weaving and not maintaining a single lane. If a field sobriety test is offered, you

can refuse, which means that you will probably be taken to jail. A breathalyzer test that shows .08 percent is an indicator of DUI in the state of Florida. Again you can refuse the test, but your license will be suspended for one year. When in doubt you should not take the breathalyzer as this test and the field sobriety test are not reliable. If the officer gives the horizontal gaze test you must be notified that the test is being given. If arrest protocol is not followed the case can be thrown out. Your license will be suspended for 6 months if you blow over .08, but you can be arrested even when you blow under .08. Look out for roadblock check points that check drivers of randomly selected vehicles, this is legal.
