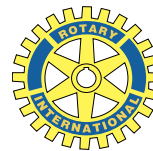

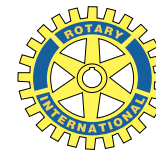

Joe Malinowski from PrePaid Legal Services spoke last week. He discussed: Business Liability: FACTA, HIPPA, Gramm Leach, Regulation E for Credit Act. Looked at affirmative defense activities (being proactive can provide some defense), e.g. a security officer, written policy both dealing with protecting customer and personnel data. Types of ID theft: drivers license, social security, medical, character, financial. Trash can ID theft accounts for 3 percent of ID theft. Regulation E Fair Credit Act: notify original creditor within 60 days after first billing mailed to you that reflects the charge. Average personal dollar loss: 2005, \$1,408; 2006, \$3,257.
