

ROTARY CLUB OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA GRANTS GUIDELINES

Grant requests will be evaluated by the committee bi-annually.

Grant requested must be completed on a “Grant Request” form.

Grants will be given only to bona fide organizations/entities.

Grants will be reviewed on several criteria:

- Grant request is for a local project (i.e. Dunedin area)
- Significance to the community
- Naming opportunity for the Rotary Club of Dunedin
- History of relationship with organization
- Grants requests cites matching funds when possible
- Grants proposing partnerships with other donors will receive priority.

Grants will generally be \$1,000 maximum but each year one grant for up to \$5,000 may be given.

All grant requests will come before the grant’s review committee.

Rotarians serving on the grants committee will be named on the Rotary club’s website as well as in a club bulletin.

No grants will be given to individuals.
